

Steel Bathroom Console Sink Base With Glass Shelf Installation




Parts:



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- Step 1. Thread adjustable leg screws (Part H) to the bottom of Parts A & B.
- Step 2. Locate the two pieces of Part F as well as Part G. Place Part G in the groves and secure with the short screw (Part I).
- Step 3. Locate Part A and Part B, face the sides with railing to each other and secure Part F from Step 2 using the long screws (Part J). Do not secure completely until the end of installation to leave room for the other support bars.
- Step 4. Install Part E to the frame using the long screws (Part J) and do not secure completely.
- Step 5. Install Part D and Part C using the same procedures as above. Once all bars are secure, use the Allen wrench to secure the screws completely to the frame.
- Step 6. Flip the sink base upright and ensure all screws have been tightened, apply Part K to Part A, B and G, then install the glass panel to the sink base. Exercise caution when installing the glass panel.
- Step 7. Level entire structure by adjusting leg screws (Part H) as necessary.
- Step 8. Once unit has been assembled place at the desired location and after leveling draw a line across the bottom of the top vertical beam (C).
- Step 9. Remove the Console sink base, find the location of the wood studs and using the marked line as a guide to install support brackets at the location of the studs, make sure at least one of the screws is secured to the wood; you will need an anchor to secure from a secondary point in the bracket.

Step 10. The depth of wall drill hole for installing anchor should be 40 mm (1-5/8") Min.

Step 11. Slide Console sink base into place and attach top sink.

Cleaning

Clean with a damp cloth only.

Avoid using metal or abrasive polishes.

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
